

Yerevan International Airport Modernization



Globalink Logistics Group, renowned for providing superior, reliable and professional transportation and logistics services, was recently contracted to handle a turnkey project by the Civil Aviation Authority of Yerevan, Armenia for the renovation and modernization of Yerevan International Airport.

The general freight, consisting of numerous containerized cargo and general cargo, as well as oversized and overweight pieces, was to be collected from multiple locations throughout Europe and the Far East. The oversized cargo consisted of 'boarding ramps' with a collective weight in excess of 200 tonnes and with several

pieces approximately 20 meters in length. This oversized freight presented a great challenge, but with proven capabilities on handling sea and surface transportation, collecting the shipments from various sites and through our own network, it was handled smoothly, efficiently and on schedule.

Upon arrival at the port of Poti, Georgia, the shipment was met by our Globalink Poti Team which was already in place with all the necessary equipment (heavy cranes, special low bed trucks, etc) and an eagerness to start. Due to the enormous volume, the oversized pieces were transloaded onto special low bed trailers while the containerized and general cargo was onforwarded by rail, as well as on our own fleet of trucks. The shipment, under escort, then left for its final destination: Yerevan, Armenia.

Having handled the delivery portion exceptionally, Globalink Yerevan then took an active part in the equipment installation. Providing all required local services including positioning cranes and trucks to having onsite personnel for supervision of lashing and other essential services, our Globalink Yerevan team worked vigorously until the job was accomplished.

So, the next time you arrive at the Yerevan airport and find yourself impressed with the airport's facilities, you will know who to thank for it.

Supersized

Globalink flexes its heavy lift muscles yet once again. Contracted to move 3 oversized pieces from Samara, Russia to Kostanai, Kazakhstan, Globalink went straight into action.



The cargo was collected from Germany and taken to St. Petersburg, Russia where Globalink's St. Petersburg office personnel arranged for a multi purpose sea/river vessel to be available to transport these oversized pieces down the Volga River to the Port of Samara. Multi axle low bed trailers were then used to collect the units from Port Samara for the 1200 kilometer journey to Kostanai. Given the dicey road conditions in several areas, the average distance covered per day was on the low side. However, having planned the most feasible route, Globalink ensured that unnecessary delays did not occur. From carrying out the road surveys, to road renovation and the presence of police escorts for the entire journey, Globalink meticulously planned every single step of the journey which resulted in delivery on time and on schedule.

Working in perfect coordination with one another, our Project Teams in Russia and Kazakhstan ensured that all details were addressed and all needed arrangements were in place with no room for any delays. The end result: Yet another job well done!

Excavators Exported:



Recently Globalink Atyrau made headlines when they handled a major construction equipment relocation from Atyrau, Kazakhstan to the Middle East. More than 100 machines weighing upto 5000 tons were imported into Kazakhstan in 2003-2004 for use at the Karabatan Site in Western Kazakhstan. It only seemed fitting that Globalink handle their massive re-export as we were the company to transport it to Kazakhstan in the first place.

Some of the equipment weighed upto 50 tons each and over-dimensional sizes had to be accommodated at each logistical step from start to finish. Some of the super oversized equipment had to be dismantled to reduce the overall dimensions to meet strict railroad compliance. A full block train was chartered to move the machines from Atyrau to the Black Sea port of Mareupol, Ukraine, with the further long journey by a special project vessel.

Handling a project shipment such as this is never an easy task. Despite the fact that the process remains the same, each project has its own individuality and a "one approach for all" style never works. At Globalink, our solution is built around the needs of the customer. Our educated and skilled staff knows exactly what is needed and required from the planning stage right upto the final loading, lashing and shipping stage. From origin to destination, these excavators were never in finer hands. We delivered them as promised – right on time.

Rig Move:

With extensive experience in the arena of heavy lifts and project management, Globalink had yet another opportunity to exhibit its prowess. Contracted to handle the transportation of an oil rig and camp site from Algeria to Kazakhstan, our Project Team went straight into action.

Globalink sent an advance team of engineers to supervise the dismantling of the rig and its transportation upto Algiers. A special vessel was chartered for the journey from the Port of Algiers upto the Black Sea Port of Mareupol. Waiting in place for the vessel was our Globalink Odessa Team which supervised the unloading and subsequent transloading onto a sea/river vessel suitable for navigation through the Volga Don River and into the Caspian Sea Port of Aktau, Kazakhstan. Upon arrival at Aktau Port, Globalink Aktau supervised the discharge and the loading onto special platforms for the final journey to Kyzyl-Orda. Given the size and weight of the shipment (approximately 3500 freight tons) with several parts being oversized, special permits were required from the Kazakhstan Railway authorities. However, this process caused no delays as all arrangements had been made by our Aktau team while vessel was still enroute. And so while the heavy pieces went by rail, oversized pieces completed the journey via trucks secured from Globalink's own fleet. The final result: Delivery done as scheduled and as promised. Once again we prove that when it comes to heavy-lifts, we are truly the champions.

Water Treatment:



Globalink Almaty was approached to handle and arrange the transportation of a water treatment plant from Malaysia to Aktau, Kazakhstan. At 600 tonnes with some oversized pieces, this was not one of the more complex moves that we have handled but at Globalink, size does not matter as importance is given to all shipments.

Globalink's experienced Projects, Rail & Ocean Team arranged for the needed vessel to collect the equipment from Port Klang and bring it to Jebel Ali Port, UAE. At Jebel Ali, our Globalink Dubai team were in place to arrange and supervise the transshipment from one vessel to another. With minimal wastage of time, the shipment continued onto Bandar Abbas, Iran where under supervision of our Iran Team, the shipment was transferred onto special low bed trailers for the journey upto Bandar Anzali, Iran. Accompanied by our Bandar Anzali office representatives, the cargo arrived at Bandar Anzali where the vessel chartered by Globalink for the journey to Aktau, Kazakhstan lay waiting. With all arrangements planned well in advance, there were no delays and the cargo departed for Aktau after being properly secured and lashed.

Globalink's Aktau Office personnel, already alerted to the arrival of the shipment, were at the port to perform the customs clearance formalities which they did in the shortest possible time and then arranged the trucking upto the final job site: an oil refinery.

Urgent Delivery to Azerbaijan

With the vast oil exploration and extraction operations going on in Azerbaijan, from time to time various equipments tend to break down which brings all operations to a grinding halt. Such was the case when Globalink received an urgent call at the 11th hour to find a way of bringing in one such spare part in the shortest and quickest way possible.

While the oil rig in question needed only one part to repair the equipment, that one part just so happened to be an oversized piece weighing in at 13 tonnes. With years of experience in the CIS and with our own network of offices to support each other, Globalink rose to the occasion.



Globalink Dubai's Road Freight Division collected the needed part from Dammam and brought it straight up to Dubai airport via a special low bed trailer. While the truck was on its way to Dubai, Globalink Dubai's Air Freight Division completed the necessary paperwork and secured the slot onboard the upcoming flight to Baku, Azerbaijan. When the plane landed in Baku, it was met by personnel from Globalink Baku who completed the required formalities in record time and off loaded the spare part from the plane onto a low bed trailer for the final leg of the journey.

From start to finish, 5 days was what it took. This outstanding achievement was only made possible due to Globalink's comprehensive coverage, proven abilities and seamless coordination between our offices. Yet another of the many examples of our offices working together as one to get the job done.

Turkmenistan - France - Turkmenistan



Recently, Globalink was contracted to handle the return of a damaged compressor for refurbishment from one of the oil companies operating in Turkmenistan. Not an extremely large piece when compared to others handled by us, the transportation aspect was slightly tricky as the destination required the shipment to be handled in 2 legs.

The first leg from Turkmenbashi to St. Petersburg was handled by our Globalink office in Turkmenbashi who arranged for the loading and dispatching of the cargo. Representatives from our Globalink Moscow office were waiting to receive the cargo at St. Petersburg to handle the second leg up to Le Havre, France. With the shipment arriving in St. Petersburg well ahead of the given schedule, on-forwarding to Le Havre was arranged by break bulk vessel.

After receiving praise for our smooth handling and ontime delivery, we received quite an unexpected treat. Delighted with the services that our customer received, we were asked to handle the return of the compressor once repaired. Upon receiving this new assignment, Globalink made all the necessary arrangements for the re-transport and upon arrival at Turkmenbashi Port our Turkmenbashi office supervised the discharging and subsequent loading onto the special low bed trailers arranged for the 900 kilometer journey to the final destination: an oil refinery at Dovletabad. At Dovletabad, needed cranes for offloading were also arranged and we are proud to say that the entire process went through smoothly and hassle free. This certainly resulted in a happy customer.

Auto Logistics Expertise:

Having made a niche for itself, and in the process earning a reputation for being one of the most reliable service providers when it comes to Auto Logistics, Globalink recently air freighted a mint condition 1962 Chevrolet Camaro from the USA to Almaty, Kazakhstan. Purchased by one of our regular customers, a vintage car enthusiast, this classic "Muscle Car" was on its way to becoming a valuable addition to his growing private collection. As an irreplaceable classic, the Camaro required delicate and careful handling and with Globalink on the job, this priceless automobile arrived at its destination in pristine condition and was met by an ecstatic owner who just couldn't wait to drive it away.

Patrol Boats from the US

As the largest enclosed body of water on earth by area, and classified by some authorities as the world's largest lake, The Caspian Sea region has grown in both strategic and economical importance. With most of the oil exploration activities centered in and around the Caspian Sea and with a vast abundance of natural resources, it is easy to understand the new found significance of this region. As several countries border the Caspian Sea, various governments are looking for ways to secure their maritime borders and to protect their resources and the various pipelines involved.

In this regards, Globalink Logistics Group was proud to provide the needed logistics services for 2 patrol boats sent on behalf of the United States Coast Guard, and destined for the Azerbaijan Marine Border Guard Division based in the capital city, Baku. Required for monitoring and guarding their waterways by the Azerbaijani Coast Guard, these specially equipped boats and their respective trailers required delivery on an urgent basis.

Keeping this urgency in mind, Globalink Georgia and Globalink Azerbaijan, working in coordination with one another, ensured that no delays would occur. After taking charge of the shipment upon its arrival at Poti, Georgia, staff from our Globalink Poti office monitored the unloading and then handled the transloading procedure for inland railings upto Baku, Azerbaijan. Following the specific handling and lashing requirements for both the boats and trailers, Globalink Poti dispatched the cargo which was then met at the destination city by our Globalink Baku Team. After completing the requisite customs clearance formalities, Globalink Baku delivered the cargo to its awaiting owners who couldn't wait to take the boats out for a spin.



Helicopter to Kazakhstan

As one of the main service providers to the Oil & Gas Industry, Globalink is routinely called on to provide quality service that customers have come to expect.

Globalink Almaty, Kazakhstan was asked to handle the shipment of a helicopter for one of the oil field operators in Kazakhstan. Needed for aerial inspections of the pipelines which are numerous and stretch for miles on end, the helicopter was required urgently so that inspections could be carried out on a much more regular basis (aerial inspections being more cost effective time-wise). Globalink arranged for the pick up of the helicopter in Riga and after having the rotor blades dismantled and packed appropriately, arranged for the airfreight to Amsterdam. At Amsterdam, one of the airfreight Hubs that Globalink operates from, our team was in place and waiting to ensure a smooth transition from one flight to the other for the final journey to Almaty. At Almaty, Globalink's Road Transport employees, already in place, completed the customs formalities at record speed and loaded the helicopter onto the waiting truck (from Globalink's own fleet) for the journey to our customers location.



Boiler from Belgium to Ukraine:

Recently Globalink Odessa undertook to deliver a shipment for a boiler plant in Ukraine. The cargo was by no means standard and consisted of 3 enormous oversized pieces with just the accessories and supporting beam alone weighing 109 tonnes.

After arranging to have the shipment collected and brought to Antwerp, Belgium, representatives from Globalink's Odessa Office were on hand to supervise the loading and lashing of the cargo and to ensure that the vessel, chartered for this project, departed for the Black Sea Port of Mariupol, Ukraine on schedule as time was of the essence. With a normal delivery time of 10-14 days, Globalink Odessa had an additional obstacle to overcome:



an upcoming long holiday week which would have resulted in a delay of 14 days. Always ready for a challenge, our Odessa office meticulously planned every single detail. The needed wagons were prearranged along with the floating crane at Mariupol Port. Pre-clearance process was initiated and upon arrival, the cargo was cleared in record time. After being unloaded on to the wagons and lashed and wrapped in special protective covers, the wagons were enroute to the factory at Khartsyk and delivered well in advance of the given deadline.

The success of this project could not have been achieved had it not been for the planning and follow through of our dedicated and professional staff at Odessa. Barely a year old, Globalink Odessa has already shown it clearly has what it takes to deliver a quality service.

However, like in the movies, we were there to save the day and delivered all the equipment to Almaty (origin points being in Europe) well in advance of the deadline. Using trucks from our own fleet, we were able to have full control over the entire transportation process, and through our track and trace system we were able to monitor same on a regular basis. As the trucks approached the destination, our Customs Department already alerted by the Road Transport Team, began the pre-clearance procedures which resulted in all goods being cleared in a very short time span.

Further expansion by Star Cinema is planned for Astana, Kyzyl-Orda and Shymkent and we look forward to playing our role there as well.

New Services:

Dangerous Goods Management Skills in the CIS:

In keeping with our continuous efforts to expand our services, Globalink is pleased to announce that its Road Transportation Division (RTD) has acquired the license for handling dangerous goods via our owned trucks. Acquiring this license is only possible after extensive research into a providers capabilities, set-up and track record and obtaining this license speaks volumes for the performance of our RTD personnel. Additionally, Globalink has also created a separate unit within its RTD Division which deals with all fleet related issues such as maintenance, Track & Trace, and driver training, education & certification programs.

Furthermore, Globalink's Air Freight Division also has a fully dedicated division to handle Dangerous Goods. Staff members receive all the requisite training and go through various re-certification trainings as well.

LCL Service from Turkey to the CIS:

Globalink Logistics Group is proud to announce the start of its LCL service from the following cities in South East Asia:

Busan will serve as the central point from where shipments will be consolidated and then on-forwarded to the above mentioned destinations including Almaty, Kazakhstan.

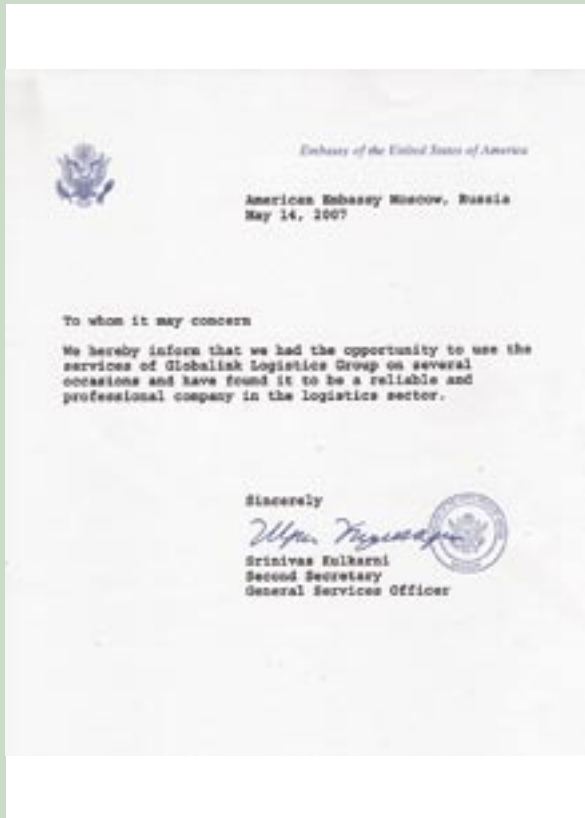
